Pentru a veni in sprijinul demersului nostru, doresc sa fac urmatoarele precizari:

- In data de 17.07.2018 (Nr inregistrare 206 NP) CNBMDM a raspuns pozitiv cererii noastre de a realiza un website de informare in limba romana, despre studiile clinice, dedicat pacientilor si profesionistilor in domeniul sanatatii, inclusiv materialele dedicate pacientilor.
- Scopul website-ului este de a prezenta intr-o maniera nepromotionala si nepartinitoare, informatii publice generale legate de studiile clinice, de legislatia UE si internationala si de proiectele de cercetare in derulare in Romania.



Cover letter for the approval of texts dedicated to general information for patients, on clinical trials, through a website (www.studiiclinice.org/www.studiiclinice.ro) which aims to inform subjects and medical staff

Dear Mr. President,

Please consider reviewing and approving the general campaign framework to inform patients about clinical trials in various pathologies, which will be posted on www.studiiclinice.org/www.studiiclinice.ro.

In order to support our application, I would like to mention the following points:

- On 17th of July 2018 (Registration Nr. 206 NP) CNBMDM responded positively to our application to create an informational website in Romanian language about clinical trials, dedicated to patients and health care professionals, including patient-related materials.
- The purpose of the website is to present, in a non-promotional and impartial manner, general public information related to clinical trials, EU and international legislation and on-going research projects/clinical trials in Romania.
- Patient information campaigns related to clinical trials in various pathologies are not promotional and are aimed at educating patients.
- These campaigns are attended by doctors and pharmacists.

The campaigns contain:

- Medical texts adapted to patients, coming exclusively from public sources some are translations and adaptations of similar materials from international sites - with the consent of foreign partners.
- (Video) testimonials of patients participating in clinical trials
- Interviews and appearances in specialized magazines, television, radio

- Short movies in informational purposes for patients
- Telephone number dedicated to patient information
- Patient education workshop events
- Filmed events with answers to patient questions answers provided by doctors and pharmacists
- General information posted on general online channels

The materials have been thought of in small pieces, so they can be read quickly and easily, in simple and unpretentious language; the concept of information presentation has been taken from the major international websites Please note that all information to patients complies with GDPR, Personal Data Protection, 2016/679 in the current version OJ L 119, 04.05.2016.

On 19 March 2019, Scala Clinical Research won the European Patient Recruitment Innovation Prize, awarded by SCRS, the Society of Clinical Studies Centers (a society representing 9500 clinical medical centers in 47 countries) for the project 'Patient Navigator in Clinical Studies' materialized in the Patient Information Campaign with Ulcerative Colitis and Crohn's Disease.
